

CWS Fiji Floods Appeal

4,500 homeless people urgently need shelter, drinking water, tinned food, school supplies, water tanks, tarpaulins, bathing and washing soap. These survivors, in the 'poorest areas' of flood affected Fiji, have been identified by our Fijian partner ECREA, as requiring the greatest need, as they can miss out on Government assistance. Counselling and psycho social support are also top priorities. "CWS has pledged to raise \$5,000 towards providing basic, urgent needs for the 4,500 people," says Pauline McKay, CWS National Director.
